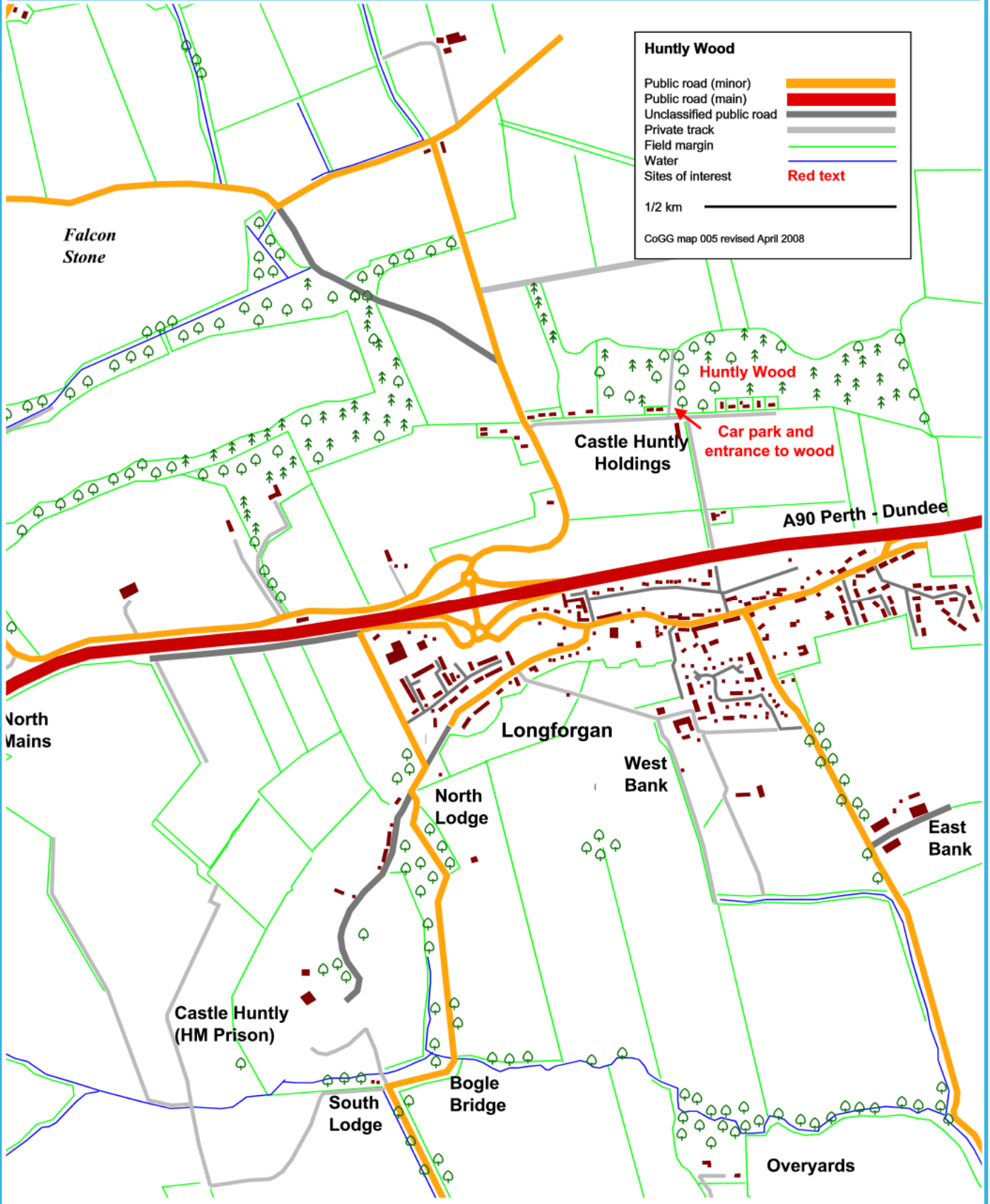




# Huntly Wood by Longforgan





# Huntly Wood by Longforgan

<b>Location</b>	Huntly Wood is approximately 7.5km west of Dundee, and 0.5km to the north of the village of Longforgan.
<b>Type</b>	Huntly Wood is owned and managed by the ' <i>Woodland Trust</i> ' and access is open to the public without charge. There are various paths through the woodland area and it is popular with local dog walkers.
<b>Description</b>	<p>The '<i>Woodland Trust</i>' Huntly Wood comprises approximately 13 Ha of diverse woodland that includes both mixed broadleaved and conifer plantings.
