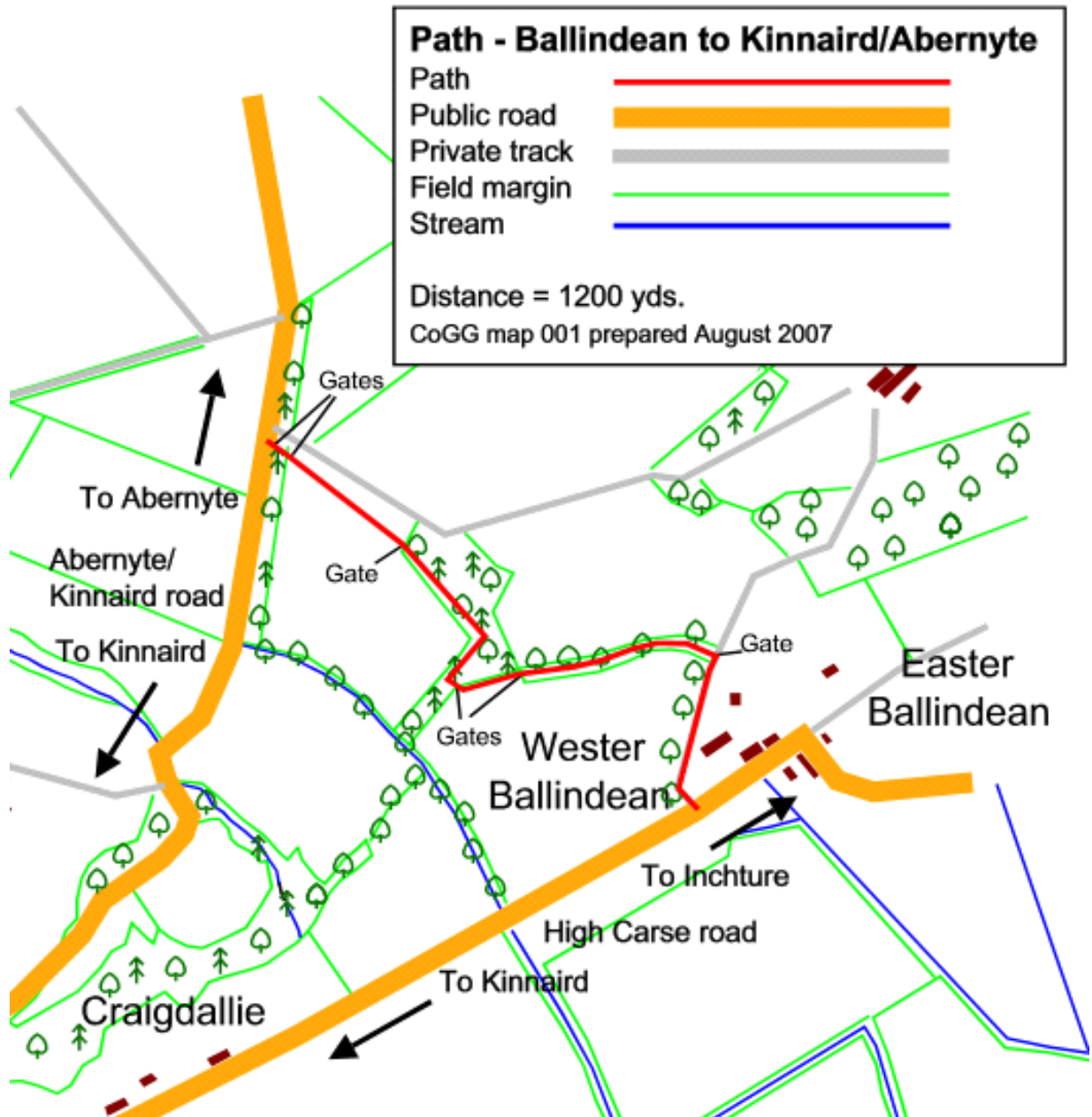




Ballindean Path





Ballindean Path

Location	The path lies just to the north of Wester Ballindean and runs between the 'High Carse Road' and the road between Kinnaird and Abernyte. It makes a good connection for a round walk <i>via</i> Kinnaird, see our next path.
Type	Newly developed path by CoGG.
Description	Path completed in August 2007. Look for the signpost to "Kinnaird Road" at Wester Ballindean. The path starts at the north side of the High Carse road where it follows a concrete track then a grassy track through a gate. The path climbs fairly steeply and after passing through a young woodland area, it passes through a field prior to accessing the Abernyte - Kinnaird road. Because most of the path is a grass path with five gates on a fairly steep incline, this makes it unsuitable for wheelchair, disabled and pushchair access.
Distance	1200 yds
Parking	Please take care not to block access, particularly to fields.

Special precautions	Please take care because some sections of the path cross fields with farm animals or livestock in them. Please shut the gates after use and please keep dogs under close control.
