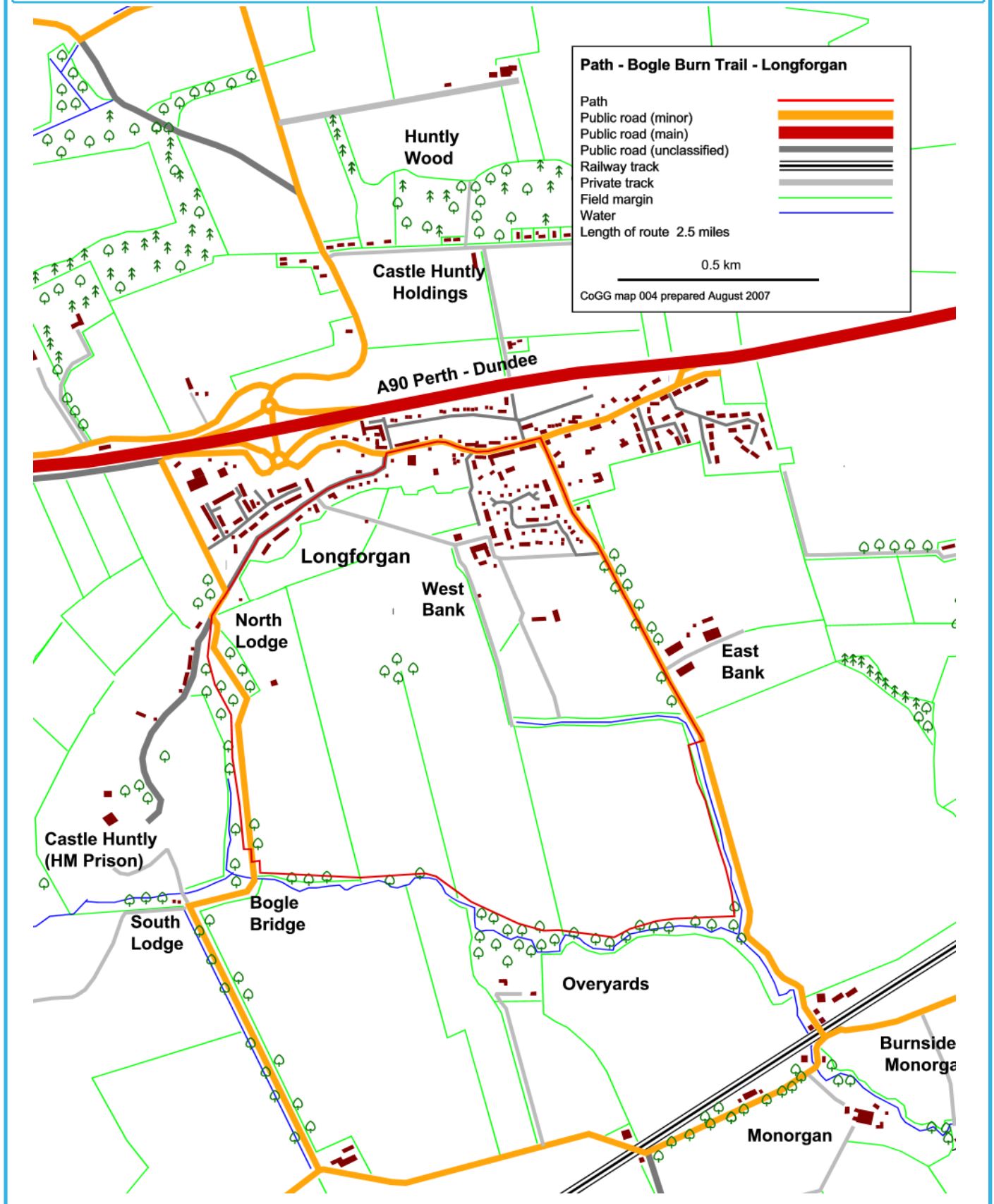




Bogle Burn Trail





Bogle Burn Trail

Location	The walk lies to the south of Longforgan village.
Type	Established path. Look out for sign posts on route. The path runs partly along some minor roads and along field margins.
Description	<p>The Bogle Burn Trail was recently established round Longforgan following an initiative by the Longforgan Primary School. They won the first prize of £2000 in the 'It's Our Future' schools competition. You can read more about their success story at (http://www.infoscotland.com/ourfuture).</p> <p>Much of the path is along field margins and is probably unsuitable for wheelchair and disabled access due to the sometimes muddy nature of the route.</p>
Distance	2.5 miles
Parking	Parking is available in Longforgan, please take care not to block access.
